What are Industry Certifications?

Industry certifications are developed by industry to show proficiency in a specific career area. These certifications are recognized at a national level to show that the certified individual can perform certain skills in the job market.

- Marketability Earning industry certifications can enhance resumes and increase the students' marketability for future careers.
- Career Relevance The state legislature works together with leaders from business and industry to identify certification(s) that are relevant in today's job market.
- **College Credit** Many of the industry certifications have statewide articulation agreements that earn student's college credit in identified programs at state funded colleges.

What are Digital Tool Certificates?

- Digital Tool Certificates endorse achievement of digital skills that are necessary to the student's academic work and future employment in grades 3 8. We are offering IC3 Computing Fundamentals, Computer Applications and Living Online to students enrolled in CTE and Research Courses.
 - The skills must include: word processing; spreadsheets; presentations, including sound, motion, and color presentations; digital arts; cybersecurity; and coding
