Junior Internship: EDUC 394-Professional Educator

REQUIREMENTS OF JUNIOR INTERNSHIP:

Junior level teaching candidates will be placed in a classroom clinical experience consisting of:

- Observing
- Teaching through whole group, one on one instruction, and small group work (Unit teaching, projects, work stations, etc.)
- Teaching a content area

SUPERVISING TEACHER REQUIREMENTS:

Supervising teachers will provide mentoring, observe and provide feedback to teacher candidates throughout the semester.

Supervising teachers will complete a teaching assessment of the teaching candidate as well as a mid program assessment of the teaching candidate. These assessments will be submitted online through the LiveText assessment management system.

Clinical Educator training is not a requirement at the junior internship level.

UNIVERSITY SUPPORT:

Stetson University will provide a letter of introduction outlining the course and field experience, as well as teacher and student expectations. An informational session will be provided for supervising teachers. A teacher education faculty member will observe, coach, complete formal observations, and provide support needed to the supervising teacher.
