2019-2020 School Attendance End of Year Report
Departmental Goal Achievement and Attendance Initiatives

During the 2019-2020 SY, the Superintendent's Attendance Initiative was continued and focused on decreasing chronic absenteeism. Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing 10 percent or more of school days including all absences, excused or unexcused and suspensions. Attendance awareness messaging to parents, students, school staff, and community stakeholders went out at the beginning of the SY in August. The district focused on attendance in September for Attendance Awareness Month with the kick off of the Everybody Every Day Campaign. The campaign included a student contest, the *Everybody Every Day Poem, Poster, Video Rap/Song Contest* which encourages students to display their artistic creativity while highlighting why school attendance is important to education and school achievement. There were 36 winners in the respective categories that were awarded. The Shirley H. Lee Community Support for School Attendance Award Recipient was awarded to Ms. Jennifer Stach, Assistant Principal, New Smyrna High, for her unwavering commitment to promoting regular school attendance. Other attendance initiatives included:

- Perfect attendance in which 217 students were awarded a certificate at their respective schools for the 2018-2019 SY
- Excellence in Attendance Award recognizes the schools with the highest attendance rate at the elementary, middle, high school, and alternative levels at the end of each semester. Winners for first semester of the 2019-2020 SY were: Cypress Creek Elementary at 96.25%; Creekside Middle at 95.45%; Deltona High at 95.2%; and Highbanks Learning Center at 78.71%. Second semester Excellence in Attendance Award winners were Coronado Beach Elementary at 97.44%, Creekside Middle at 96.65%, Spruce Creek High at 95.32%, and AMIKids Volusia at 93.25%.
- Other district attendance initiatives included:
 - ❖ The Superintendent's Attendance Challenge Award features the schools who have achieved the highest reduction in chronic absenteeism (CA) during the third nine weeks. The percentage of improvement was determined by the difference between the school's chronic absenteeism rate at the end of the first semester of the 2019-2020 school year and the rate of chronic absenteeism on March 12, 2020. For the Superintendent's Attendance Challenge, there was only one school at the elementary level, Coronado Elementary, with a 4.34% reduction in chronic absenteeism. At the alternative level, Riverview Learning Center reduced their CA by 38.5%; Highbanks Learning Center reduced their CA by 12.5%; and PACE Center for Girls reduced their CA by 5.3%. There were no reductions in CA at the middle and high school levels during this time frame.
 - ❖ The Great Strides in Attendance Award honors the schools who had the highest rate of reduction of CA for the 2019-2020 school year at the elementary, middle, and high school levels. Each winning schools' CA rate was compared from the end of last school year (2018-2019) to the end of the current school year (2019-2020). The Great Strides in Attendance Award Winners were Ormond Beach Elementary with a 7.9% reduction; Heritage Middle with a 7.6% reduction; and T. Taylor Dewitt High with a 4.8% reduction.
- At the end of the 2019-2020 SY, 38 schools met the chronic absenteeism goal of reducing their CA rate by 10%
- eCare Initiative with VCS and Advent Health which began in January 2019 continued at every school in the District throughout the school year until school closings occurred in March 2020 (Distance Learning) due to COVID-19.
- Collaboration continued with Stewart Marchman Act-CINS/FINS Program, State Attorney's Office, and Volusia County Teen Court Program to follow-up on truancy referrals.

The 2019-2020 School Social Work Services Attendance Goals:

1. To work collaboratively with Florida Hospital to reduce the chronic absenteeism rate at all schools. Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing at least 10% of school days in a year for any reason, excused or unexcused. Social Workers promoted attendance and engagement initiatives, and provided support to schools, students, and their families to improve attendance. The overall rate of students who were chronically absent was 16.2% which represents 10,070 students. The district rate for homeless students who were chronically absent was 14.3% which represents 1443 students. The district rate for ESE students who were chronically absent was 28.1% which represents 2831 students.
2. To decrease the percentage of students who are habitually truant with emphasis on the homeless population. Social Workers worked towards this goal by monitoring school attendance, disaggregating attendance data, promoting attendance and engagement initiatives, and providing support to schools, students, and their families to improve attendance.

School Social Workers assisted school-based staff in identifying all truant students (students with 15 or more unexcused absences within a 90 calendar period) at each of their assigned schools by providing monthly habitual truancy reports and inquiring about interventions for those students on the list. Documented interventions were provided to the Coordinator of School Social Services monthly. The overall rate of students who were habitually truant for the 2019-2020 SY was 4.9% which represents 3052 students of the total population of truant students. The overall rate of homeless students who were habitually truant was 10.2% which represents 311 students of the total population of truant students. The overall rate of ESE students who were habitually truant was 26.6% which represents 811 students of the total population of truant students.

For the 2019-2020 SY, 1501 attendance referrals were received. School Social Workers provided support to schools, students, and their families through PST meetings, phone calls, home visits, and letters with information about compulsory school attendance. When more assistance was needed, School Social Workers referred parents and students to community stakeholders for support in improving school attendance. School Social Workers submitted 1 Teen Court referral, 63 CINS/FINS referrals, and 70 ASAP referrals. There were 11 parents who were referred to adult court through the State Attorney's Office for violation of the compulsory school attendance law.

School Social Workers were supportive in assisting the district in resolving DNE withdrawal codes again this school year in order to ensure that the district's count was accurate for the submission to FLDOE for annual withdrawal reporting (i.e. Survey 2-5). On 8/26/19 (Day 11), there were 1235 students coded as DNE. All DNE codes were resolved by 10/11/19.

School Social Workers provided follow-up services to 376 terminated home education students and families. The Team assisted the Hospital Homebound/Home Instruction/Off Campus Instruction programs by providing follow-up services for 5 students who were not accessing the services. Follow-up services were provided to 54 students identified as Learnfare students. School Social Workers assisted Student Accounting with following up with parents of 436 students who had W02 withdrawal codes and 270 students who had W24 withdrawal codes. Two School Social Workers assigned to the alternative education schools provided transition services for those students who were placed at Highbanks Learning Center or Riverview Learning Center by the District Student Placement Committee or their respective (ESE) IEP teams.

In October 2015, the Obama Administration launched *Every Student, Every Day: A National Initiative to Address and Eliminate Chronic Absenteeism* with a goal to decrease chronic absenteeism by at least 10 percent each school year. Research shows that missing at least 10 percent of school days in a year for any reason is a primary cause of low academic achievement and a powerful predictor that students will eventually drop out of school.

*Note: Calculations for Online Learning attendance data began in the 2013-2014 school year. For the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 school years, Online Learning only included full-time Volusia Virtual School. In the 2018-2019 school year, Online Learning attendance reporting was not available in the Student Information System.

**Note: Beginning the 2019-2020 school year, a new Student Information System (FOCUS) was implemented. The habitual truancy report was not developed until mid-year and only includes students who are compulsory age whereas before included all students who were habitually truant regardless of age. The chronic absenteeism report was not developed until the summer of 2020. All Florida schools were closed due to COVID-19 on 3/23/20 and no attendance was taken during Phase 1 (3/30/20-4/15/20) of Distance Learning in Volusia County Schools. Attendance was captured during Phase 2 of Distance Learning in Volusia County Schools from 4/16/20-5/29/20. Absences were defined as no evidence of engagement in a digital platform and/or no response to contact attempts within a week. Through the end of the third quarter (3/12/20), the district wide truancy rate was 2.3% and the district wide chronic absenteeism rate was 21.2%.
