WHY MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORTS?

- ☐ Mental Health concerns can affect a person's thinking, behaviors and their emotional state.
- ☐ They can disrupt the persons ability to:
 - ☐ Work or attend school,
 - ☐ Carry out daily activities, and/or
 - ☐ Engage in satisfying relationships
- □ 3 out of 4 individuals with a mental illness report they have experienced stigma

Impact



50%

50% of all lifetime cases of mental illness begin by age 14 and 75% by age 24.1

- Consists of school social workers, mental health clinicians and substance abuse professionals

VCS MENTAL HEALTH SUPPORT

- Currently total of 28 clinicians throughout the district
- Respond to all schools, including
 Charter and Alternative Education
- Aid students, families, schools and staff


