ZERO TOLERANCE

- Firearms/Weapons
- False reporting
- Acts that pose a serious threat to school safety
 - Defined Level 4
 - Law enforcement
- Petty acts of misconduct/misdemeanors not considered a threat to school safety
- Encourage alternatives to suspension & expulsion
- Volusia in accordance

RESPONSE TO REFERRALS

- School completes investigation
 Includes student's explanation
- Administration determines appropriate offense coding(s) as well as response
- Parents/Guardians may request a conference with the principal
- Level III may be referred to district
- Level IV <u>must</u> be referred to district
