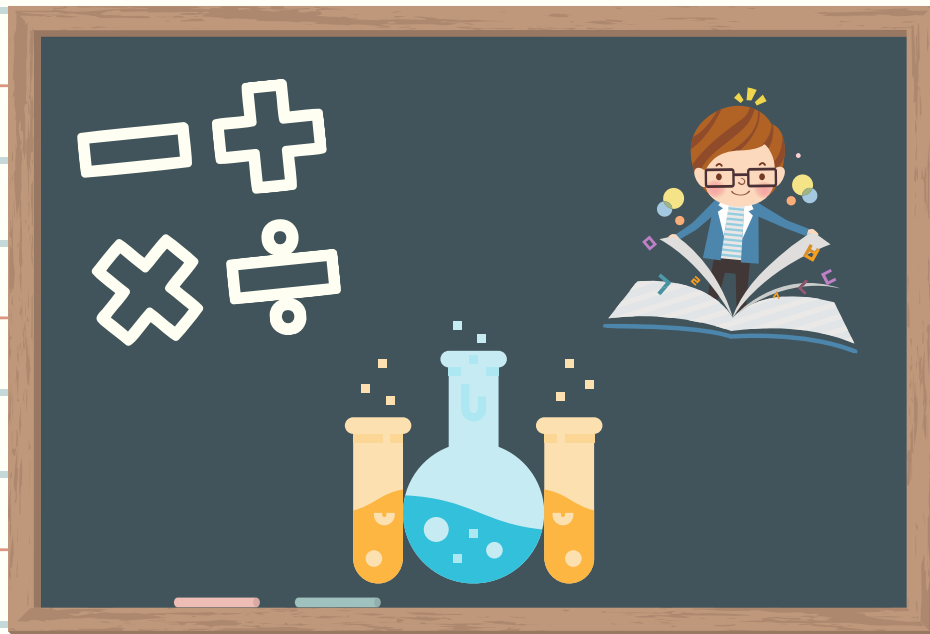

## VPortal Quick Guide for VCS Families

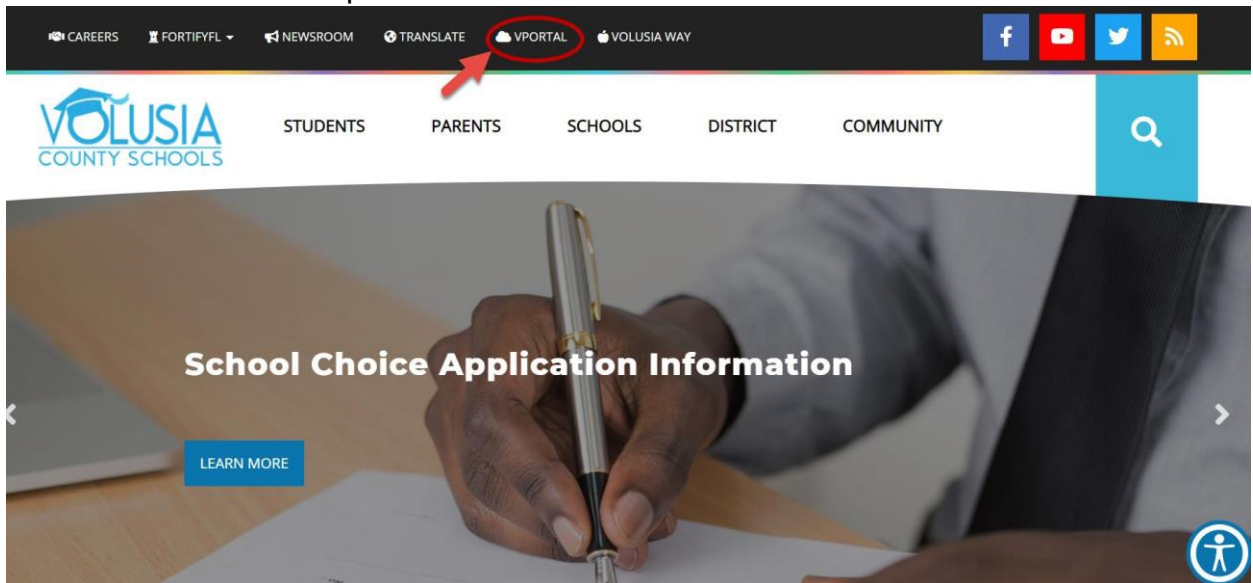
### What is VPortal?

Your Cloud, One Login.

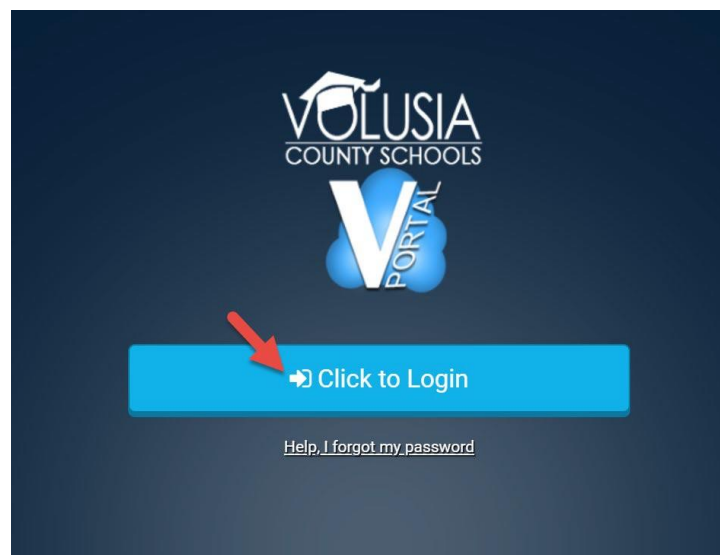
VPortal is your personal cloud desktop giving you access to all your apps, files, and classes from anywhere. You have accessibility to all your digital textbooks, resources, and learning management systems. VPortal is accessible from all device types.

### How can I access VPortal?

1. Go to the Volusia County Schools Homepage
  - a. [www.vcsedu.org](http://www.vcsedu.org)
2. Click on 'VPortal' in the top banner

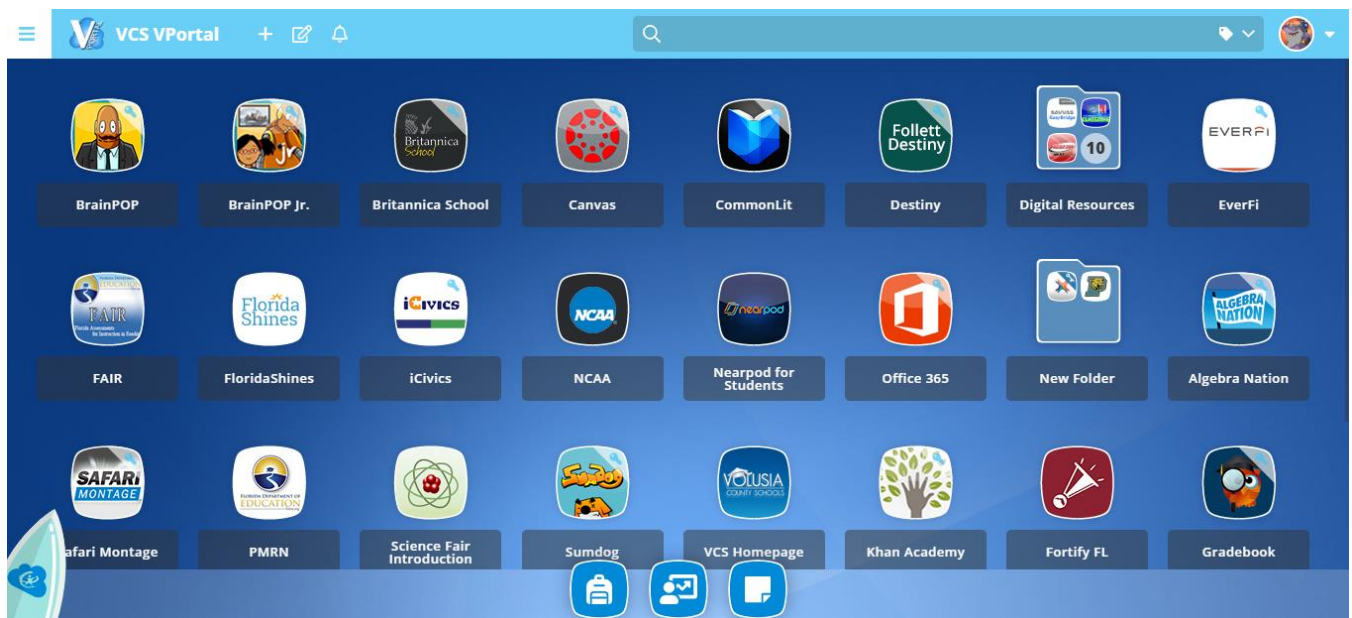


3. Click on the blue banner 'Click to Login'



4. Enter VCS email address (1ALPHA@vcs2go.net or 2ALPHA@vcs2go.net)
  - a. Enter password (student birthday in mm/dd/yyyy format is default password)
  - b. Click 'Sign In'

- Your teacher can reset your password through the 'Teacher Console'. Please contact your teacher. Passwords will reset to the student's birthday in the mm/dd/yyyy format.

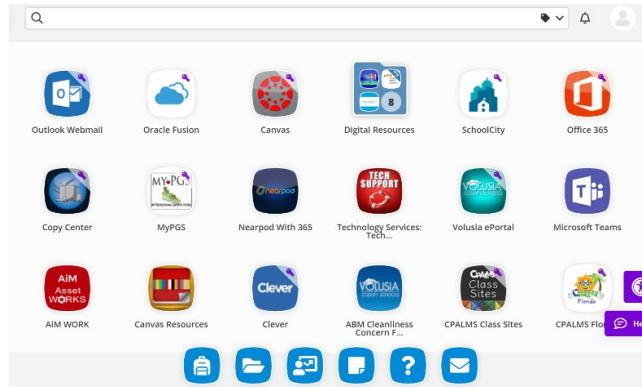

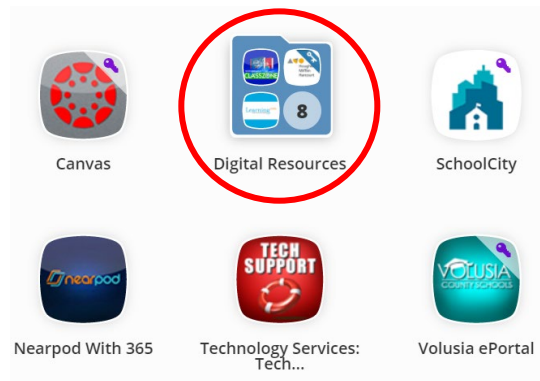
### Student Quick Guide for Benchmark Advance

#### How do I access assignments in Benchmark Advance?

Once you are logged in to VPortal:



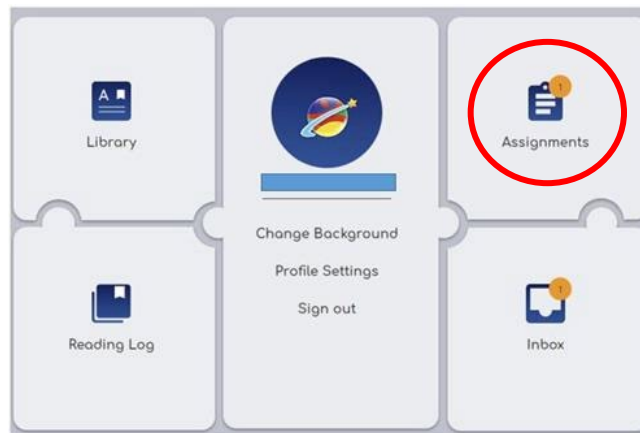
1. Go to the folder titled “Digital Resources.”



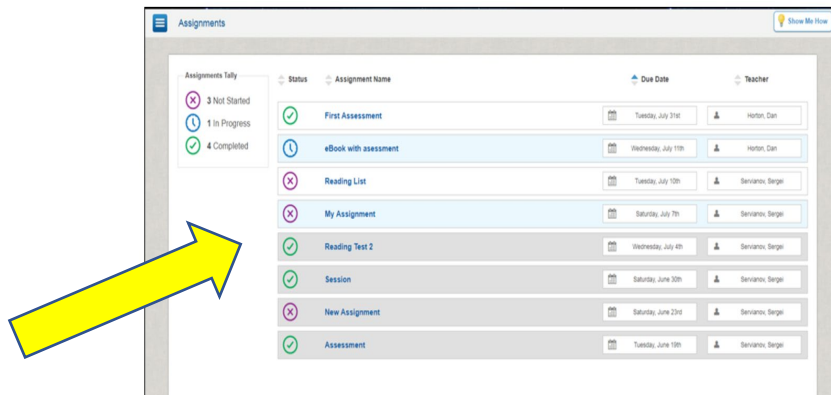
2. Click on the tile that says “Benchmark” and you will automatically be directed to the Benchmark Advance Dashboard.



3. Click on the “Assignments” tile.



4. You will now have access to your Assigned Tasks.



5. Click on the assignment and begin working.

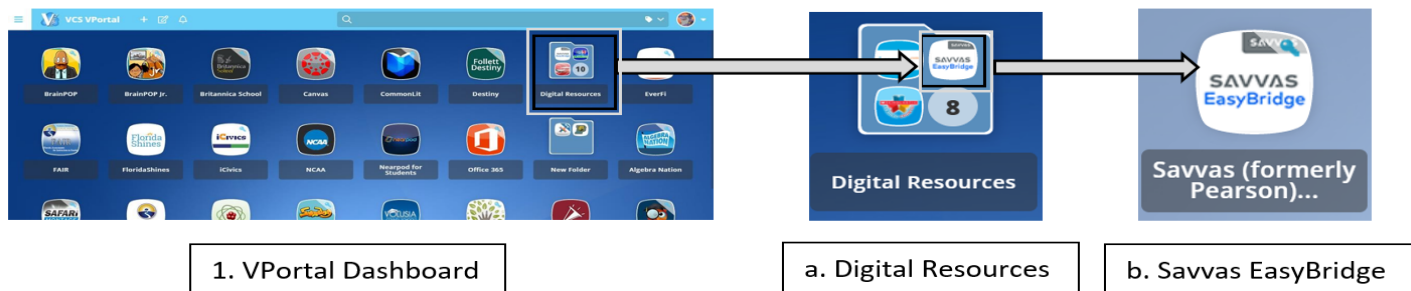
6. Contact your teacher if you have questions about the assignments.

## Math and Science

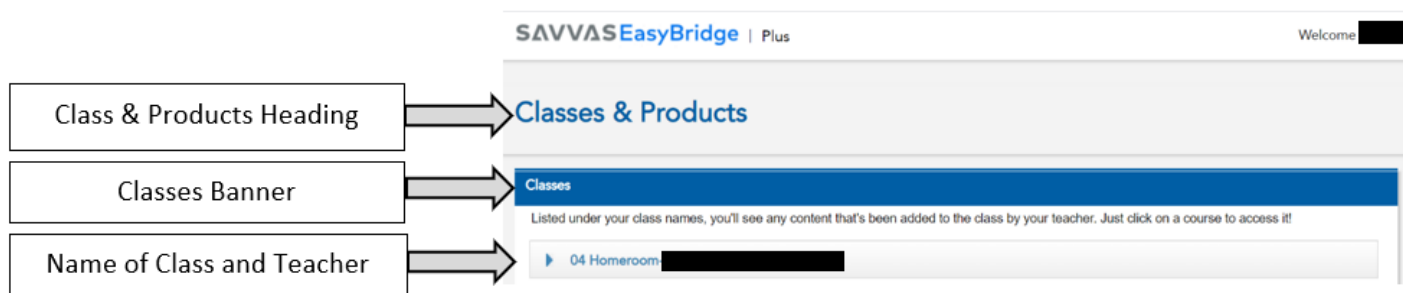
### Student Quick Guide for Savvas

**STEP 1:** From your VPortal Dashboard:

- a. Click the folder titled: Digital Resources
- b. Click the icon titled: Savvas EasyBridge (formerly Pearson)

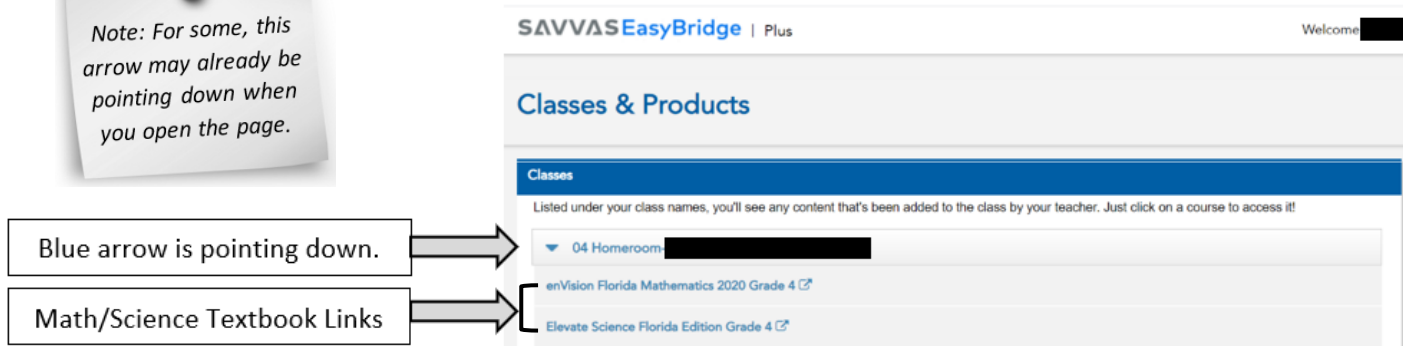


**STEP 2:** Locate the “Classes & Products” heading, and the “Classes” banner. Under the “Classes” banner you will see the name of your class and teacher.

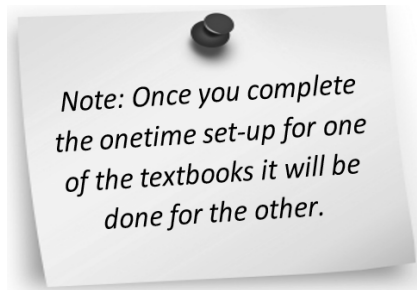


**STEP 3:** Click the blue arrow ( ▶ ) to the left of your Class and Teacher’s name. Your enVision Mathematics and Elevate Science textbooks will appear as links under your Class and Teacher’s name.

*Note: For some, this arrow may already be pointing down when you open the page.*



**STEP 4:** If this is your first time accessing your math and science textbook online, you will need to follow the steps for a brief, onetime set-up.



Set-up looks like this.

If this is NOT your first time accessing your math and science book, then go to Step 5.



**STEP 5:** You will see your homepage, and a list of assignments that have been provided by your teacher for Math and/or Science. You can click directly on the assignment(s) listed.



Assignments will be listed in the space under the headers.



**STEP 6:** If you do not have any assignments, you can still access the material in your online textbooks.

- Click “Programs” on the right under the headings. Your current textbooks will be listed.
- Click the textbook you would like to access.



**STEP 7:** A homepage for the textbook will appear. Topics will be under the Table of Contents. Topics may be in a “thumbnail view” or a “list view”. The content and materials are the same in both views.



**STEP 8:** Click on the Topic you are currently learning and explore the content and material that your online textbook offers.



# Logging in to i-Ready from Home

(on a computer)

1. In your web browser, go to <https://www.vcsedu.org>
2. Click on VPORTAL option from the top menu
3. Click to Login to VPORTAL
4. Enter the student email (student alpha followed by @vcs2go.net [ALPHA@vcs2go.net](mailto:ALPHA@vcs2go.net)) and password (The default password is the student's birthday in MMDDYYYY format, unless the student changed their password.)  
Click Sign In
5. Find and select the Digital Resources folder within VPORTAL
6. Find and click on the i-Ready icon within the Digital Resources folder

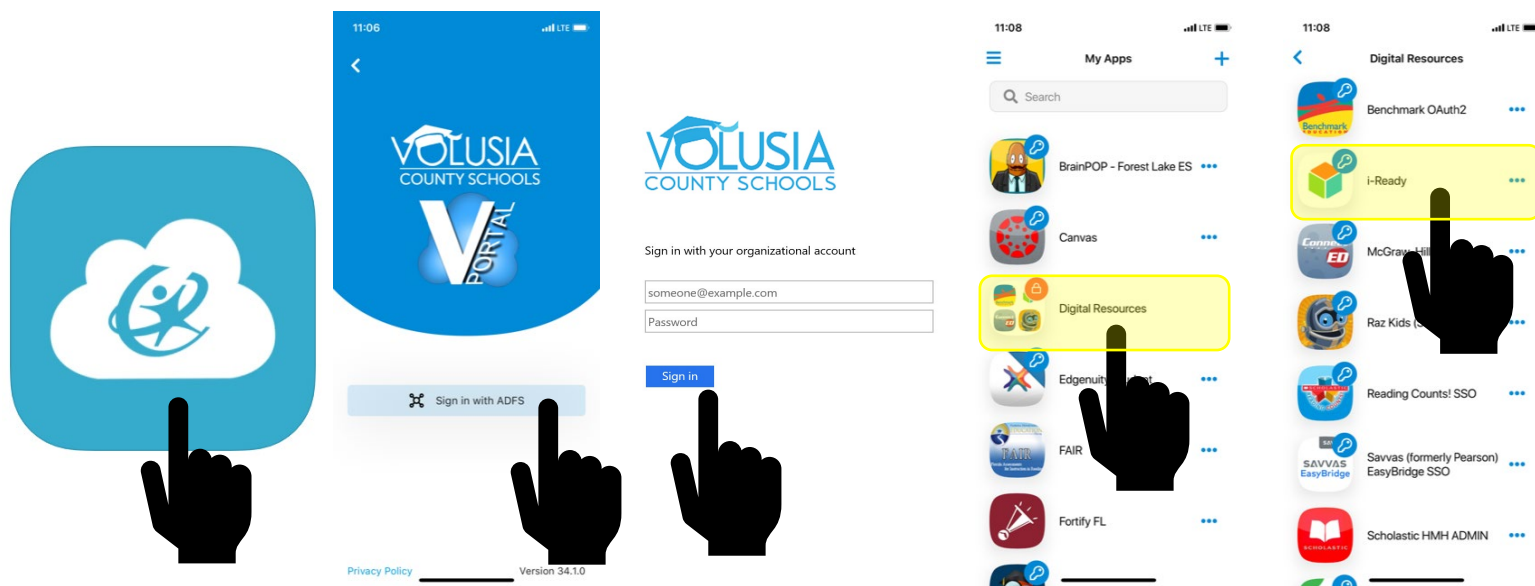

# Logging in to i-Ready from Home

(on an i-Pad)

- ❖ Make sure you have ClassLink app on your device
- 1. Click on the ClassLink app (Select Volusia County Schools if needed)
- 2. Sign in with ADFS
- 3. Sign in to VPORTAL
  - Enter the student email (student alpha followed by @vcs2go.net [ALPHA@vcs2go.net](mailto:ALPHA@vcs2go.net))
  - and password (The default password is the student's birthday in MMDDYYYY format, unless the student changed their password.)
- 3. Click on the Digital Resources folder within VPORTAL
- 4. Click on the i-Ready icon within the Digital Resources folder
