Required VCS registration documents include:

- (a) Original birth certificate
- (b) Current shot record (Florida Form 680)
- (c) Current physical record (Florida Physical Form 3040)
- (d) Two forms of Volusia County residency that clearly indicate parent/guardian name:
 - parent/guardian's valid Florida ID card or driver's license
 - copy of current electric/utility bill
 - copy of non-cellular telephone bill
 - lease or rental agreement with rent receipt
 - bill of sale/property deed with tax receipt showing homestead exemption
- (e) Valid Certificate of Eligibility (COE) from the Early Learning Coalition of Flagler and Volusia
- (f) Child's Social Security card if available
