RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

Licensed by the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD), Duvall Homes operates a growing network of 16 individual group homes throughout Volusia County serving the needs of people with developmental disabilities from Florida and across the United States.

Since 1945, Duvall Homes has had a long history as an organization that provides residency, 24-hour care, programs and services and adult day training for clients age 22 and over with Autism, Down syndrome, Cerebral Palsy and other intellectual and developmental disabilities. As part of Duvall Homes' Residential Services and Habilitation, supervision and training are provided to assist clients to acquire, maintain and become more independent in life-skill areas of daily living, selfcare activities and other social and community-integrated skills.

Residential Habilitation Training is developed and implemented by each individual's Support Team, including the client's family, Residential Program Managers (Group Home Managers), Direct Support Professionals (DSPs), Qualified Developmental Disabilities Professionals (QDDP), Life Skills Development Coordinator, medical staff, friends and other support people.

Individual goals are set by the client with the assistance of trained and certified members of their Support Team as required by APD, who maintain quarterly reports that monitor activities of daily living as well as educational, fitness and nutritional goals. These personally developed goals are set to achieve the highest level of independence possible and are updated each year.

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80 individuals with developmental disabilities from the community, and from residence at Duvall Homes, receive six 30-to-45 minute classes of guided curriculum each day, Monday to Friday, from 8:45 a.m. to 2:45 p.m., in Duvall Homes' Adult Day Training (ADT) Program. That's more than 1,500 hours of instruction each year focused on providing the highest quality of life, reaching the greatest level of independence and celebrating every achievement, big and small alike.

ADULT DAY TRAINING

ADT takes place at Duvall's Opportunities Enrichment Center on our Glenwood, Florida, campus. Providing social and vocational experiences in the community are key components to an effective educational program. Trained and certified professionals are required by Florida's Agency for Persons with Disabilities to maintain quarterly reports and create experiences that empower, inspire and promote dignity. They are mentors who are dedicated to helping each individual participant in our care achieve personal success no matter what their abilities may be.

ADT participants are active in community service with the following organizations: Meals on Wheels; Publix Super Market; Rise Against Hunger; Habitat for Humanity; Journey's End Animal Sanctuary; and Art For Everyone Public Exhibitions; and others.

Employees in Duvall Homes ADT Program understand and respect that not everyone can paint, speak or feel confident to volunteer in the community, but with time and our commitment of care, many ADT participants develop and improve hand-eye coordination and dexterity, learn to concentrate and work independently, and demonstrate confidence and self-pride.
