2020-2021 School Attendance End of Year Report
Departmental Goal Achievement and Attendance Initiatives

During the 2020-2021 SY, Volusia County Schools as well as all other districts in Florida began school facing the COVID-19 Pandemic. The district offered parents 3 learning modalities including in-person, Volusia Live (online with a live teacher), and Enhanced Volusia Online Learning. Attendance for all 3 learning modalities was taken throughout the school year and attendance policies and procedures were followed. CDC guidelines for quarantining were closely monitored by the district and followed at each school. As a result of the extreme numbers of quarantines, school attendance district wide was adversely affected. However, the School Social Services Team continued to focus on decreasing chronic absenteeism by assisting students, families, and school staff with alleviating barriers to school attendance. Chronic absenteeism is defined as missing 10 percent or more of school days including all absences, excused or unexcused and suspensions. The district's rate at the end of the school year for chronic absenteeism was at 31.3%. We were not able to continue the Superintendent's Attendance Initiative due to funding. The eCare Initiative with VCS and Advent Health continued at every school in the district throughout the school year. Collaboration continued with Stewart Marchman Act-CINS/FINS Program, State Attorney's Office, and Volusia County Teen Court Program to follow-up on truancy referrals.

The 2020-2021 School Social Work Services Attendance Goals:

1. To reduce the chronic absenteeism rate at all schools. Social Workers promoted attendance and engagement initiatives, and provided support to schools, students, and their families to improve attendance. End of year data showed that 17,988 students were chronically absent (31.3%) district wide. The district rate for homeless students who were chronically absent was 10.1% which represents 1808 students. The district rate for ESE students who were chronically absent was 26.1% which represents 4692 students. As noted above, this significant increase of chronically absent students was due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and its effects on the multiple positive cases and quarantines which required students to be absent at least 10-14 days at one time as well as other barriers including technical issues, transportation, parents' fears of the pandemic, etc.
2. To decrease the percentage of students who are habitually truant with emphasis on the homeless population. Social Workers worked towards this goal by monitoring school attendance, disaggregating attendance data, promoting attendance and engagement initiatives, and providing support to schools, students, and their families to improve attendance. School Social Workers assisted school-based staff in identifying all truant students (students with 15 or more unexcused absences within a 90 calendar period) at each of their assigned schools by providing monthly habitual truancy reports and inquiring about interventions for those students on the list. Documented interventions were provided to the Coordinator of School Social Services monthly. The overall rate of students who were habitually truant for the 2020-2021 SY was 6.8% which represents 3894 students of the total population of truant students. The overall rate of homeless students who were habitually truant was 9.7 % which represents 379 students of the total population of truant students. The overall rate of ESE students who were habitually truant was 27.3% which represents 1064 students of the total population of truant students.

School Social Workers provided support to schools, students, and their families through PST meetings, phone calls, home visits, and letters with information about compulsory school attendance with follow-up of 1572 referrals regarding attendance. From those referrals, follow-up services were provided to 301 terminated home

education students and families. The Team assisted the Hospital Homebound/Home Instruction/Off Campus Instruction programs by providing follow-up services for 5 students who were not accessing the services. Follow-up services were provided to 176 students identified as Learnfare students. School Social Workers assisted Student Accounting with following up with parents of 279 students who had W02 withdrawal codes and 150 students who had W24 withdrawal codes. When more assistance was needed, School Social Workers referred parents and students to community stakeholders for support in improving school attendance. School Social Workers submitted 132 CINS/FINS referrals, and 168 ASAP referrals. There were 25 parents who were referred to adult court through the State Attorney's Office for violation of the compulsory school attendance law based on 23 students' patterns of non-attendance.

School Social Workers were supportive in assisting the district in resolving DNE withdrawal codes again this school year in order to ensure that the district's count was accurate for the submission to FLDOE for annual withdrawal reporting (i.e. Survey 2-5). On 9/15/20 (Day 11), there were 1538 students coded as DNE. In addition to the 1538 students, there were 16 VOL students who received follow-up by school social workers. All DNE codes were resolved by the end of the school year.

Two School Social Workers assigned to the alternative education schools provided transition services for those students who were placed at Highbanks Learning Center or Riverview Learning Center by the District Student Placement Committee or their respective (ESE) IEP teams. As of 6/4/21, 43 students were placed at Riverview Learning Center and 39 students entered Riverview. At Highbanks Learning Center, 57 students were placed, and 48 students entered the program.

In October 2015, the Obama Administration launched *Every Student, Every Day: A National Initiative to Address and Eliminate Chronic Absenteeism* with a goal to decrease chronic absenteeism by at least 10 percent each school year. Research shows that missing at least 10 percent of school days in a year for any reason is a primary cause of low academic achievement and a powerful predictor that students will eventually drop out of school.

*Note: Calculations for Online Learning attendance data began in the 2013-2014 school year. For the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 school years, Online Learning only included full-time Volusia Virtual School. Beginning the 2018-2019 school year, Online Learning attendance reporting was not available in the Student Information System.

**Note: Beginning the 2019-2020 school year, a new Student Information System (FOCUS) was implemented. The habitual truancy report was not developed until mid-year and only includes students who are compulsory age whereas before included all students who were habitually truant regardless of age. The chronic absenteeism report was not developed until the summer of 2020. All Florida schools were closed due to COVID-19 on 3/23/20 and no attendance was taken during Phase 1 (3/30/20-4/15/20) of Distance Learning in Volusia County Schools. Attendance was captured during Phase 2 of Distance Learning in Volusia County Schools from 4/16/20-5/29/20. Absences were defined as no evidence of engagement in a digital platform and/or no response to contact attempts within a week. Through the end of the third quarter (3/12/20), the district wide truancy rate was 2.3% and the district wide chronic absenteeism rate was 21.2%.

***Note: In the 2020-2021 school year, all Florida schools reopened despite the COVID-19 pandemic. The rates were considerably higher this SY because of the multiple positive cases and quarantines which required students to be absent at least 10 days at one time, difficulty with technology for students who were enrolled in one of two online learning options, and parents' fears of the pandemic.
