Health Insurance Documentation Requirements for Dependents

WHO YOU MAY COVER:

- Your legal Spouse
- Your legal Dependents

Your dependent children up to ages allowed by contract, state and federal law.

Note: If you elect new dependent coverage for **health insurance**, you are **required** to submit the necessary documentation for that dependent to the Risk and Benefits Management Department within your allowed 30-day enrollment window. Failure to provide the necessary documentation within the enrollment window will result in dependent coverage not being processed or valid and employee only coverage will be implemented.

ALL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE EMAILED TO <u>Insurance@volusia.k12.fl.us</u> or via <u>interoffice mail</u> to Risk and Benefits Management at DeLand Administration Bldg. (DAC) no later than your 30 day election window.

Required Documents to Verify Eligibility of Dependents

Legal Spouse

- Legible photocopy of a certified marriage certificate and
- Joint documentation a current document addressed to both parties such as a utility bill, mortgage statement, 1040 income tax form or auto insurance statement

Natural Child, Stepchild or Adopted Child

 A certified birth certificate or court document that establishes the relationship between employee and dependent.

Child Under Legal Guardianship

• Court document that establishes permanent legal guardianship, assigned to the employee or spouse. The document must be signed and/or stamped by a member of the court.
