  - School-wide Rules & Expectations

  - Common language for classroom management across levels
  - o Professional development & random opportunity for coaching of essential skills

- <u>**Recommended Programs for Targeted Intervention** (not yet in place at every school):</u>
  - WHY TRY
    - <sup>°</sup> Strength-based approach to help children overcome challenges & improve outcomes in areas of truancy, behavior & academics
  - Second Step Violence Prevention Program
    - ° Curriculum designed to help students learn vital social skills such as empathy, problem solving and cooperation
  - Student Success Skills
    - ° Program for improving skill competence in areas of goal-setting, problem solving and community involvement
  - Triple P Parenting Program
    - <sup>o</sup> Multi-level parent and family support strategy that aims to prevent severe behavioral, emotional & developmental problems
  - Aggression Replacement Training
    - Program for aggressive adolescents and young children that aims to enhance interpersonal skills & self-mediation
  - Behavior Education Program
    - Program for heightened supervision & intervention of identified at-risk students
  - Peer Tutoring/Peer Networks
  - Mentoring

#### **Tier 3 Supports**

- ESE Behavior Support Teams (Secondary)
  - <sup>o</sup> School-based problem solving teams meeting to reduce the number of ESE discipline referrals, suspensions and arrests by addressing problems before the behaviors escalate to the point of disciplinary action
- Non-violent Crisis Intervention
  - Proactive & systematic approach to crisis intervention and effective management of disruptive and assaultive behavior.
    SED-NET
  - ° Florida's Multiagency Service Network for Students with Emotional Disabilities.
- Behavioral Services (FBA/BIP)
  - Proactive approach to determining the function of problematic behavior and provide supports and teaching of productive replacement behaviors
- Individual Student Counseling for E/BD students
  - <sup>°</sup> Counseling provided as a related service, by qualified district personnel, to students identified in need as determined through the IEP process
