FL Rule 6A-4.0051 Language:

Educators who instruct students in reading must have earned 40 in-service points, or 2 college credits (or a combination thereof) in the use of explicit, systematic, and sequential approaches to reading instruction, developing phonemic awareness, and implementing multisensory intervention strategies. If so, then for recertification starting in 2025, this requirement applies

to you!

Explicit SYSTEMATIC Sequential Reading Instruction

Hours & Coursework

- Hours earned within 10 years of renewal may be used towards the requirement.
 - Coursework used to earn a certificate or endorsement <u>may</u> also be used to renew.
 - Courses must address reading instruction as written in rule 6A-4.0051.

*Credits that count toward the 40 hour Reading requirement may also count toward the 20 hour ESE recertification requirement.
