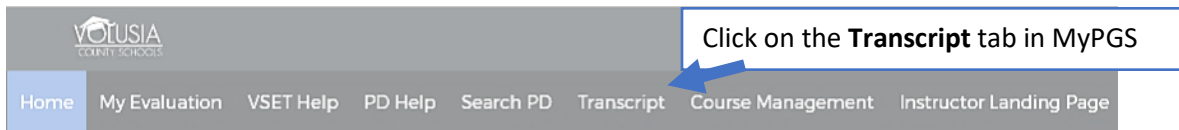


Reading Your Transcript and Credit Bank in MyPGS

You will need 120 in-service credits to renew your regular Florida Professional Educator's Certificate each renewal period, and 20 of these points must be ESE/Students with Disabilities credits.

In-service (non-bankable) credits must be earned within your current renewal period to be used to renew. Bankable credits include courses earned as a Teacher in ESE/Students with Disabilities* (*earned after July 1, 2014), Reading, and ESOL. Unused bankable points will carry to your next renewal.



Scroll down to your Credit Bank. It may take a moment to load the data.

Credit Bank

The **Credit Bank** shows the total ESE and in-service credits you have that can be used to renew your certificate.

The reset dates show the end date of your last 5-year certificate. If this is incorrect, contact the PLSI office.
