

*A Resolution of the School Board of Volusia County, Florida,
Proclaiming April 23 through April 27, 2018 as
"Afterschool Professionals Appreciation Week"
for the School District of Volusia County*

KNOW ALL CITIZENS BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Volusia County School Board, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereby recognizes April 23 through April 27, as "Afterschool Professionals Appreciation Week" to recognize and thank our Extended Day Enrichment Program (EDEP) employees.

WHEREAS, 24 million school-aged children are in some form of child care outside of school time; and

WHEREAS, our future depends on providing high quality child care services for all children and families within our community; and

WHEREAS, EDEP offers after school programs in 40 Volusia County schools and provides a safe environment for students to develop friendships and explore new hobbies and interests; and

WHEREAS, approximately 3,700 students are enrolled in EDEP and participate in offerings such as homework monitoring, music, arts & crafts, computer skills, recreational activities and more.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN OFFICIAL SESSION, DULY ASSEMBLED IN DELAND, FLORIDA, THIS 10th DAY OF APRIL 2018, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The School Board of Volusia County, Florida recognizes the importance of the contribution that Extended Day Enrichment Program (EDEP) employees make to the educational process; and

Section 2. The School Board of Volusia County, Florida on behalf of all students and personnel, does hereby resolve to proclaim April 23 through April 27, as "Afterschool Professionals Appreciation Week" for Volusia County Schools, urging all parents, students, and employees to recognize the tireless efforts of our EDEP employees who care for children of working parents; and


Section 3. The School Board of Volusia County, Florida commends EDEP employees for their commitment to providing experiences that build a strong foundation for our children's future;
