WHEREAS, Native American customs and traditions are respected and celebrated as part of a rich legacy throughout the State of Florida and the United States of America through community celebrations as well as cultural, artistic, educational and historical activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN OFFICIAL SESSION, DULY ASSEMBLED IN DELAND, FLORIDA, THIS 23rd DAY OF OCTOBER, 2018 AS FOLLOWS:


