

Resolution No. 2019-04

*A Resolution of the School Board of Volusia County, Florida,
Recognizing School Crossing Guards*

KNOW ALL CITIZENS BY THESE PRESENTS that the Volusia County School Board, Volusia County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereby recognizes School Crossing Guards.

WHEREAS, each and every school day, thousands of dedicated individuals, whom we call crossing guards, spend countless hours assisting our children across busy street intersections as they arrive and depart from school; and

WHEREAS, local government entities place a top priority on child safety issues and awareness and that education plays a critical role in ensuring the safety of our children and crossing guards who are there to assist them during their commute to school; and

WHEREAS, we acknowledge that crossing guards provide an invaluable service to our communities and they receive little recognition or compensation for their tireless efforts; and

WHEREAS, we realize that crossing guards often encounter adversarial, dangerous and sometimes hostile attitudes from individuals who are more concerned with their own personal agendas than the safety of school children.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN OFFICIAL SESSION, DULY ASSEMBLED IN DELAND, FLORIDA, THIS 29th DAY OF JANUARY, 2019 AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the School Board of Volusia County, Florida, on behalf of all students and personnel, does hereby resolve to recognize School Crossing Guards for Volusia County Schools; and


Section 2. That the School Board of Volusia County recognizes and appreciates the significant services provided by crossing guards; and


Section 3. That a copy of this Resolution be spread upon the official minutes of the School Board of Volusia County, Florida, distributed to all public schools and appropriate governmental bodies in Volusia County, Florida.


