RESOLUTION NO. 2018-02

A Resolution of the School Board of Volusia County, Florida, expressing support for the City of Daytona Beach's Safe Routes to School Infrastructure grant application benefiting Turie T. Small and Campbell Middle Schools.

WHEREAS, the Safe Routes to School Program is a federal reimbursement program that facilitates the planning, development and implementation of projects that will improve safety and reduce traffic and encourages children to walk and bicycle to school; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation created a grant program to allocate the federal funds to eligible applicants; and

WHEREAS, Volusia County School District staff has participated in the MPO's Bicycle Pedestrian Safety Studies around area elementary schools; and


WHEREAS, the School Board of Volusia County desires to support the multiagency effort to provide safe and alternative modes of transportation;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be spread upon the minutes of the School Board of Volusia County, Florida, submitted to the Transportation Planning Organization, and be used to supplement the City of Daytona Beach's grant applications.


