Founded over 100 years ago, Devereux operates a comprehensive national network of therapeutic, educational, and prevention services positively impacting the lives of tens of thousands of individuals and families every year.

Specialized therapeutic services are offered to survivors of human trafficking, including LGBTQ+ youth and those at-risk of sexual exploitation. Services include trauma-informed therapeutic support, individualized clinical treatment, as well as individual and group therapy through a multidisciplinary team of professionals. Counseling and support is available to assist with but not limited to: specialized survivor treatment, behavior problems, risky sexual behaviors, relationships, at-risk LGBTQ+ youth, self-esteem, depression, generational trauma.

Individuals identified as at-risk, or survivors of commercial sexual exploitation, may be provided with a specialized case manager for additional support in connecting individualized services and enrichment activities to help with personal development. Ongoing support will also be provided via consultation led by a licensed mental health counselor with extensive experience in working with survivors of exploitation.
